RULES OF THE ASSOCIATION

INTRODUCTION

Unless the contrary intention appears, in these rules words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine. Words in the singular include the plural and words in the plural include the singular. The word "Club" shall be held to include all affiliated bodies.

1. NAME

The Association shall be known as the Berkshire and South Buckinghamshire Amateur Swimming Association (BSBASA).

2. COMPOSITION

The Association shall consist of swimming clubs affiliated to the Amateur Swimming Association South East region (ASA SER) and allocated to it by the ASA SER, and of individual members as permitted under Rule 6. The Amateur Swimming Association (ASA) and the ASA SER define the geographical area of the Association as such portions of Berkshire and Buckinghamshire as lie south of latitude 51 degrees 37 minutes North.

3. OBJECTIVES

The objects of the Association shall be:

- 3.1 To promote the teaching and practice of swimming, synchronised swimming, diving and water polo.
- 3.2 To encourage formation of swimming clubs
- 3.3 To stimulate public opinion in favour of providing proper accommodation and facilities for the pursuit of the sport
- 3.4 To promote and govern County Championships and Competitions
- 3.5 To select and govern teams and individuals to represent the County

4. GOVERNANCE

- 4.1 The Association and all individual members of the Association acknowledge that they are subject to the laws, rules and constitution of:
 - a) The ASA SER
 - b) The ASA, to include the ASA / Institute of Swimming Code of Ethics
 - c) British Swimming (in particular its Doping Control Rules and Protocols and its Disciplinary Code)
 - d) FINA, the world governing body for the sport of swimming in all its disciplines
 [a to d together known as "the Governing Body Rules"]

- 4.2 The business and affairs of the Association shall at all times be conducted in accordance with the Governing Body Rules and in particular the Laws and Technical Rules of the ASA ("ASA Law"), as the same may be revised from time to time, specifically to include:
 - a) The Association shall in accordance with ASA Laws adopt the ASA Child Protection Procedure
 - b) Individual members of the Association shall, in accordance with ASA Laws, comply with the ASA Child Protection Procedures
 - c) The Association shall adopt and comply with the ASA "Guidelines for Handling Internal Club Disputes".
- 4.3 The Association shall accept the responsibilities inherent in recognition as a sub-region of the ASA SER, as set out in the Constitution of the Region [see web site www.southeastswimming.org].

5. AFFILIATION

The Association shall be affiliated to any competent body at the direction of the Management Board.

6. INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS

- 6.1 Persons who may be elected by the Management Board as individual members shall pay an annual subscription of £5.00, or may become Life Members on payment of £20.00.
- 6.2 The Council may award honorary life membership of the Association, at its discretion. The Management Board shall review nominations for the award of honorary life membership and make recommendations thereon to the Council.

7. FINANCE

- 7.1 The financial Year of the Association shall end on 31 March.
- 7.2 Funds and other property of the Association shall be applied to the furtherance of the objectives of the Association, or for any charitable purpose. No funds or other property of the Association shall be paid to or distributed among members of the Association, except as reimbursement of legitimate expenses incurred on behalf of the Association.
- 7.3 Every member of the Management Board, servant and agent of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association and it shall be the duty of the Association to pay all costs, losses and expenses which any such person may properly incur or for which he may become liable by reason of any contract entered into or act or thing done by him in good faith in the discharge of his duties.
- 7.4 Members of the Management Board and of any sub-body appointed by the Management Board or any person duly appointed by the Association to act with its authority shall be paid their expenses necessarily incurred through that membership or appointment by the Association at the prevailing ASASER rates.
- 7.5 In the event of the dissolution of the Association the funds remaining shall be devoted to objectives similar to those of the Association.

8. THE COUNCIL

- 8.1 The Council shall consist of the following members;
- 8.1.1 Officers of the Association (see rule 9.1.1).
- 8.1.2 Members of the Management Board
- 8.1.3 The Vice President and Past Presidents of the Association.
- 8.1.4 Up to three delegates from each affiliated club on the basis fixed for representation to the ASA SER Council [This is presently:
1 from each club having up to 50 members
2 from each club having between 51 and 200 members
3 from clubs having more than 200 members.]
- 8.2 The annual meeting of the Council shall be held in July.
- 8.3 Fourteen clear days written notice of the Annual Council Meeting shall be given to each club secretary and to members of the Council.
- 8.4 With the notice of the Meeting there shall be an agenda, an annual report, financial report and examined accounts, and a list of nominations for the Officers and members of the Management Board.
- 8.5 All nominations shall be required to reach the Hon. Secretary by 23rd June on the prescribed form (available from the Hon. Secretary) that shall be signed by the proposer, the seconder and nominee, each of whom should be a member of the Association or of a club assigned to the Association.
- 8.6 Any election necessary shall be by ballot and only members personally present shall be entitled to vote. In the event of an equality of votes, the chairman shall have an additional casting vote.
- 8.7 In the event that the number of nominations does not exceed the vacancies, properly nominated persons shall take office without ballot, at the relevant point in the agenda, with the exception of the President, who shall take office as set out in Rule 10.5.
- 8.8 A Special Meeting of the Council may be called by resolution of the Management Board. The Management Board shall call a Special Meeting of the Council to be held within six weeks of the receipt of a written requisition signed by no fewer than six delegates representing six different clubs. Such requisition shall state the business for which the meeting is to be called and no other business may be transacted. Fourteen clear days written notice of such a meeting shall be given to each club secretary and to all members of the Council, accompanied by an agenda.
- 8.9 A quorum for Council meetings shall be ten members of the Council.
- 8.10 A subject that has been voted on at a Council Meeting shall not be discussed again by the Council within six months, except by resolution of the Management Board.

9. MANAGEMENT BOARD

- 9.1 The management of the Association shall be vested in a management board, eight to form a quorum, which shall comprise:

- 9.1.1 The President, Hon. Secretary, and Hon. Treasurer, (the Officers of the Association)
- 9.1.2 The Vice-President
- 9.1.3 Up to 12 members elected from and by the Council.
- 9.1.4 Any vacancy that occurs shall be filled by a majority decision of the remaining members of the Management Board for the remainder of the term.
- 9.2 The Management Board shall have the following powers and duties:
- 9.2.1 To enforce the observance of the laws, rules and conditions of the ASA, the ASA SER and the County Association.
- 9.2.2 To suspend from activities wholly within its own jurisdiction, any Club or individual found guilty of an infringement of the rules and conditions of the Association and to remit or amend any previous judgement passed on due cause being shown, unless such judgement is under appeal.
- 9.2.3 To exercise financial control over the funds of the Association and to prepare a report and balance sheet of each year's activities for submission to the Council.
- 9.2.4 To render to the ASA SER all such information as the ASA SER Management Board may require.
- 9.2.5 To appoint annually representatives to the ASA SER Council.
- 9.2.6 To co-opt persons to assist in its work, without power to vote.
- 9.2.7 To appoint such persons and sub-bodies as are in its opinion necessary to deliver the sport, and shall determine their terms of reference and methods of operation.
- 9.2.8 To interpret the Rules of the Association and to decide upon any point which is not covered hereby and provide for all matters not otherwise set forth.
- 9.3 A Management Board minute that has been approved may not be rescinded at a later date until after a period of six months except by Annual Council Meeting or Special Council Meeting.
- 9.4 The Management Board may declare that any member, who has been absent from three consecutive meetings, shall have vacated his seat.

10. PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT

- 10.1 The role of the President shall be to represent the Association.
- 10.2 The President shall have the right to chair meetings of the Council and the Management Board.
- 10.3 If the President declines that duty, or is absent from a meeting, the Council or Management Board shall elect a chairman from among its members. The chairman shall have the right to vote on each motion and, in the event of an equality of votes, shall have an additional casting vote.
- 10.4 The Management Board shall review nominations for the office of President and make recommendations thereon to the Council at the time of election.
- 10.5 Election of President shall normally take place one year ahead of their presidential year and the President Elect shall act as Vice President for that year.

11. EXAMINER OF ACCOUNTS

- 11.1 The Council shall appoint annually, at the Annual Council Meeting, an independent examiner for the following year, to review the accounts. The Examiner must not be a member of the Management Board or related to a member of the Management Board.

12. BADGES

- 12.1 When the President of the Association takes office he shall be awarded a County President's Badge.
- 12.2 Persons on the County lists of officials are entitled to wear the County Official's Badge.

13. ALTERATION OF RULES

No alteration to these Rules and General Championships Conditions 1 to 11 can be made except at the Annual Council Meeting or at a Special Council Meeting called for that purpose, and then only by a two-thirds majority of members present and voting; alterations so made shall be subject to the approval of the ASA SER. All proposals for alteration or addition to Rules and General Championship conditions to be brought before the Annual Council Meeting must reach the Hon. Secretary by 23rd June.



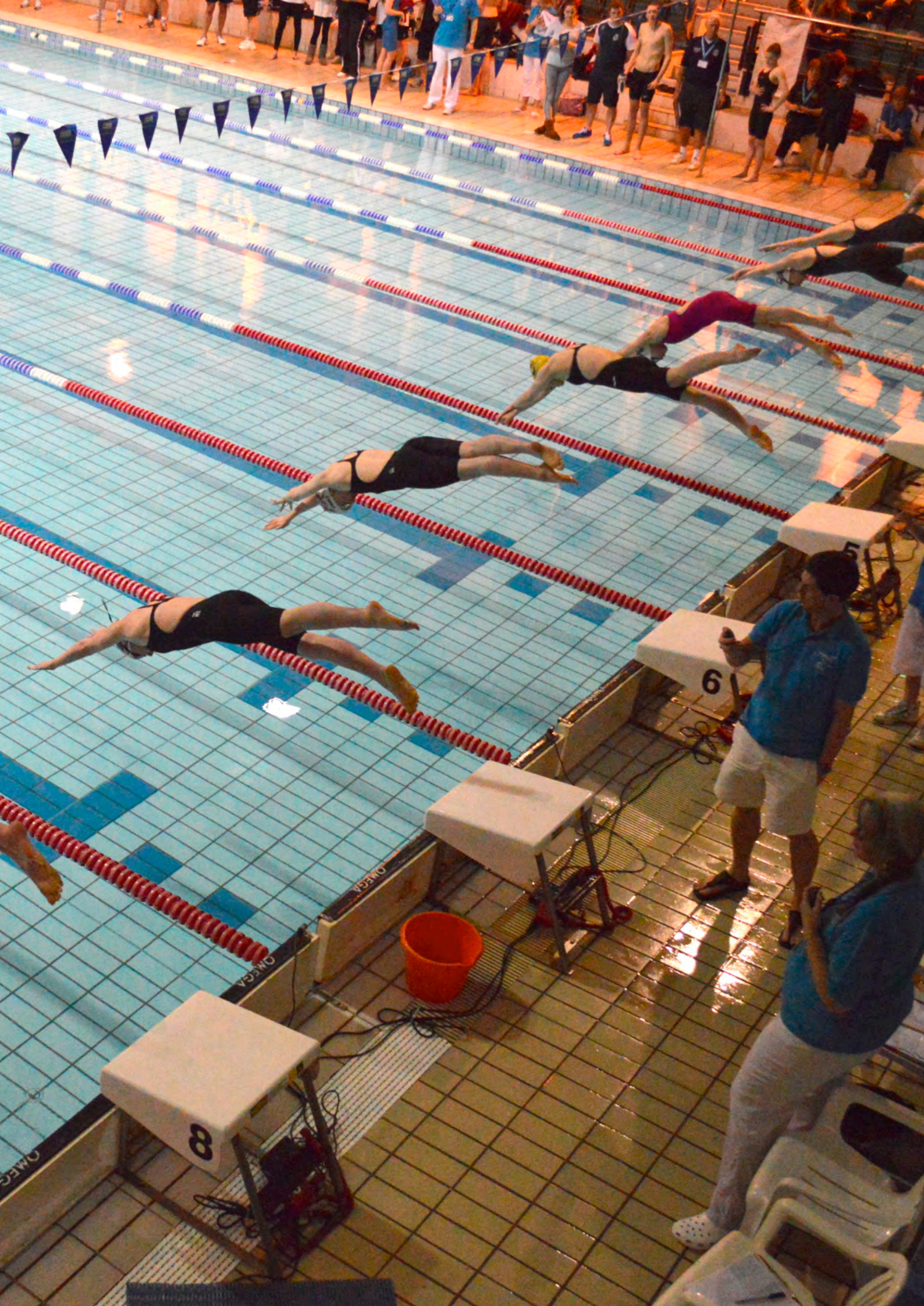

GENERAL CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

(conditions 1-11 are applicable for all disciplines)

1 The Championships shall be held in accordance with ASA Laws and ASA Technical Laws.

2 Championships shall be conducted annually upon dates and at venues to be fixed by the relevant discipline committee.

3 Individual Championships shall be open to competitors as defined by the ASA General Competition Laws who, since 1 October of the year preceding the year of the Championships, have been in continuous membership of clubs affiliated to the Association, except where provided in individual discipline conditions.

4 For Team Championships the General Championships conditions together with the following additional conditions shall apply:

4.1 Team Championships shall be open to all clubs affiliated to the Association.

4.2 Deleted.

4.3 The Individual Championship 'eligibility' condition 3 above shall apply to each member of the team.

5 A competitor entered in the name of one club for an event in any discipline may not be entered for another event in that discipline in the name of another club during that Calendar year except with the agreement of the relevant discipline committee and the clubs concerned.

6 A competitor who has competed in the Championships of another County shall not be eligible to compete in the Association's Championships in the same discipline in the same calendar year. In the case of a competitor removing from the County, he shall be eligible to compete during the year whilst qualifying to compete in the Championships of another County.

7 Entry Fees

7.1 The entry fee for each individual Senior and Junior Championship and Team Championships shall be determined by the relevant discipline committee.

7.2 If an entry is incorrect then the entry fee shall be forfeited.

8 The age of competitors in Junior Individual and Team Championships shall be subject to specific discipline conditions.

9 In Junior Championships the date of birth of the competitor must be stated on the entry form. In the case of Team Championships the date of birth of each competitor must be shown on the entry form or the team declaration. Birth certificates or appropriate evidence must be produced if requested by the Executive.

10 Any dispute or question arising that the foregoing conditions do not provide for shall be determined in the first instance by the relevant discipline committee and thereafter by the Executive.

11 Any holder of a trophy who fails to return that trophy by the specified date shall not be allowed to take custody of any trophies which he or she might be awarded during the County Championships in that calendar year.

SWIMMING

12 All Championships shall be held in still-water, in pools not less than 25 metres in length. Any movement of the water due to the normal operation of the filter system may be disregarded.

13. Entries shall be made in accordance with the published entry procedure before the specified closing date.

13.1 Swimmers must have equalled or bettered, during the twelve months prior to the cut off date specified, the entry time set by the Swimming committee for each event entered. Such times (with the exception of the 800m and 1500m freestyle) must have been achieved at ASA licensed meets (levels 1 - 4) where the results have been posted on to the ASA Rankings database by the closing date.

13.2 Entry times for the 800m and 1500m freestyle can be achieved in any competition, however preference will be given to competitors who have entered with times on ASA Rankings.

13.3 Entry times can be 25 metre times or converted from 50m times using the Equivalent Performance conversion tool provided by the County Association and based on tables published by the ASA.

13.4 Documentary evidence of the competitor's submitted time may be requested by the Swimming Committee.

14. Individual Championships shall be open to a competitor as defined by the ASA General Competition Laws who at the closing date for entries is a member of a club affiliated to the Association and is registered with the ASA with Category 2 membership.

15. Swimmers shall be entered in the programme and shall compete in time order, fastest first (except swimmers will compete slowest first in the 400m, 800m and 1500m freestyle events). Only under exceptional circumstances shall a competitor be allowed to compete out of programme order and then only by permission of the Referee and/or Championship Secretary.

16. Unless at least two competitors or teams swim, the race will not be held, except that the holder of an Individual Championship shall be entitled to swim over and hereby retain the title having made a valid entry in accordance with these Conditions.

17. 17.1 All events of 200 metres or longer and the 100m Individual Medley will be decided on heat time classification. The results of the other events shall be decided by finals,

17.2 Competitors in the Junior Individual Championships shall be 14 years of age and under on the last day of the county championships competition.

17.3 The Junior Team Championship shall be for teams comprising swimmers meeting the BAGCAT qualification criteria in the County Age Conditions.

17.4 The fastest 8 swimmers shall swim in the Championship final, and there shall be two reserve swimmers. The finish order in the Championship final shall determine the Championship placings.

17.5 The fastest 8 junior swimmers, excluding any junior swimmers who have won a place in the Championship final, shall swim in the Junior final, and there shall be four reserve swimmers. The finish order in the Junior final shall determine the Junior Championship placing, except where junior swimmers are placed in the Championship final. In such cases all junior swimmers placed in the Championship final will be placed, in finish order, above the Junior final winner; regardless of the respective times achieved in the finals.

17.6 Where swimmers withdraw from finals, reserve swimmers shall take their place. A junior reserve swimmer promoted to swim in the Championship final will automatically be withdrawn from the Junior final. Names of finalists and reserves shall be publicly announced as soon as possible after the completion of the heats. There will be no swim offs for equal placed swimmers and in such cases the number of swimmers in the Championship and Junior finals shall be reduced as necessary.

17.5 Medals shall be awarded to the first, second and third in each competition.

18. All officials shall be appointed or approved by the Executive.

19 Inter-Club Aggregate Competition – Men and Women

19.1 Points shall be awarded for up to the first six competitors in the event, in the men's and women's championships only, including team events, in the following manner: Winner 6 points; Second 5 points; Third 4 points; Fourth 3 points; Fifth 2 points; Sixth 1 point. No two clubs can make use of the same competitor for the purpose of counting points in these competitors in any one year.

19.2 The total number of points obtained by the Club shall be added together on completion of the Championships and the Club obtaining the highest aggregate shall be declared the winner. In the event of a dead heat on aggregate points of the Clubs concerned shall be declared joint winners.

20 These Championships conditions may be supplemented by additional conditions to ensure the smooth running of the competition.

DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS

SPEED SWIMMING County Age Group Competitions Conditions

1 The competitions shall be held in accordance with the ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.

2. The Competitions shall be open to a competitor as defined by the ASA General Competition Laws who at the closing date for entries is a member of a club affiliated to the Association and is registered with the ASA with Category 2 membership. A swimmer who competes in Age Group Competitions of another County shall not be eligible to compete in the Berkshire and South Buckinghamshire ASA competitions in the same year.

3. The competitions shall be swum for the following age groups and the ages shown MUST be reached by the final day of the competition.

3.1 For individual events, 10/u years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15/16 years, and 17 years and over.

3.2 For team events

3.2.1 Boys 11 years and under (age at last day of competition)

3.2.2 Girls 11 years and under (age at last day of competition)

3.2.3 Girls BAGCAT 10-14 years (age at last day of BAGCAT Nationals in that year)

3.2.4 Boys BAGCAT 10-14 years (age at last day of BAGCAT Nationals in that year)

3.2.5 Girls Youth 15-18 years (age at last day of Youth Nationals in that year)

3.2.6 Boys Youth 15-18 years (age at last day of Youth Nationals in that year)

4. Entries shall be made in accordance with the published entry procedure before the specified closing date

4.1 Swimmers must have equalled or bettered, during the twelve months prior to the cut off date specified, the entry time set by the Executive for each event entered. Such times (with the exception of the 800m and 1500m freestyle) must have been achieved at ASA licensed meets (levels 1 - 4) where the results have been posted on to the ASA Rankings database by the closing date.

4.2 Entry times for the 800m and 1500m freestyle can be achieved in any competition, however preference will be given to competitors who have entered with times on ASA Rankings.

4.3 Entry times can be 25 metre times or converted from 50m times using the Equivalent Performance conversion tool provided by the Association and based on tables published by the ASA.

4.4 Documentary evidence of the competitor's submitted time may be requested by the Executive.

4.5 Swimmers shall be entered in the programme and shall compete in time order, fastest first (except swimmers will compete slowest first in the 400m, 800m and 1500m freestyle events). Only under exceptional circumstances shall a competitor be allowed to compete out of programme order and then only by permission of the Referee and/or Championship Secretary.

5. Revised entries and entry times will not be accepted after the closing date of the competition.

6. If an entry is incorrect then the entry fee shall be forfeited. No refunds will be given for any reason.

7. The entry times are for a 25 metre pool.

8. All events will be decided on heat time classification.

9. The Parker Cup and Lambert Shield will be awarded to the 14 and under girl and boy swimmer (respectively) with the highest points score. Events counting towards the Parker Cup and Lambert Shield will be 50 m Freestyle, 50 m Butterfly, 50 m Backstroke, 50 m Breaststroke, 200 m Freestyle and 200 m, Individual Medley. Points are awarded as follows: 1st - 6 points; 2nd - 5 points; 3rd - 4 points; 4th - 3 points; 5th - 2 points; 6th - 1 point.

10. Medals shall be awarded to first, second, and third in each competition and rosettes to 4th to 8th place irrespective of the number of entries.

11. The entry fees shall be determined annually.

12. Any dispute or question arising for which the foregoing conditions do not provide, shall be resolved in the first instance by the Swimming Committee and thereafter by the Executive of the County Association.

13. These conditions may be supplemented by additional conditions to ensure the smooth running of the competition.

CONDITIONS FOR ESTABLISHING COUNTY RECORDS

(Applications for a County Record must be made to the Swimming Events Manager in accordance with the following conditions)

- 1 An application for a County Record will only be accepted in respect of a swimmer who, at the time of setting the record, has been in continuous membership of a Club assigned to the County Association for a period of at least three calendar months.
- 2 Records established in County Championships and other events officially promoted by the Association will automatically be credited to the winner concerned. All other records can only be set at Level 1 or Level 2 ASA licensed meets, or meets at which an English record can be set, and must be claimed in writing by the swimmer, or person acting on their behalf, to reach the Swimming Events Manager within two months of the event, enclosing the time card, or official results' sheet.
- 3 All records must be made in still water. Any movement of water due to the normal operation of the filtration system may be disregarded.
- 4 Long course records shall be made only in pools of 50 metres [or 55 yards length]. Short course records shall be made in pools of less than 50 metres and not less than 25 metres length.
- 5 A Junior record will be recognised only if it is made by a swimmer who is under seventeen years of age on 31st December in the year of competition.

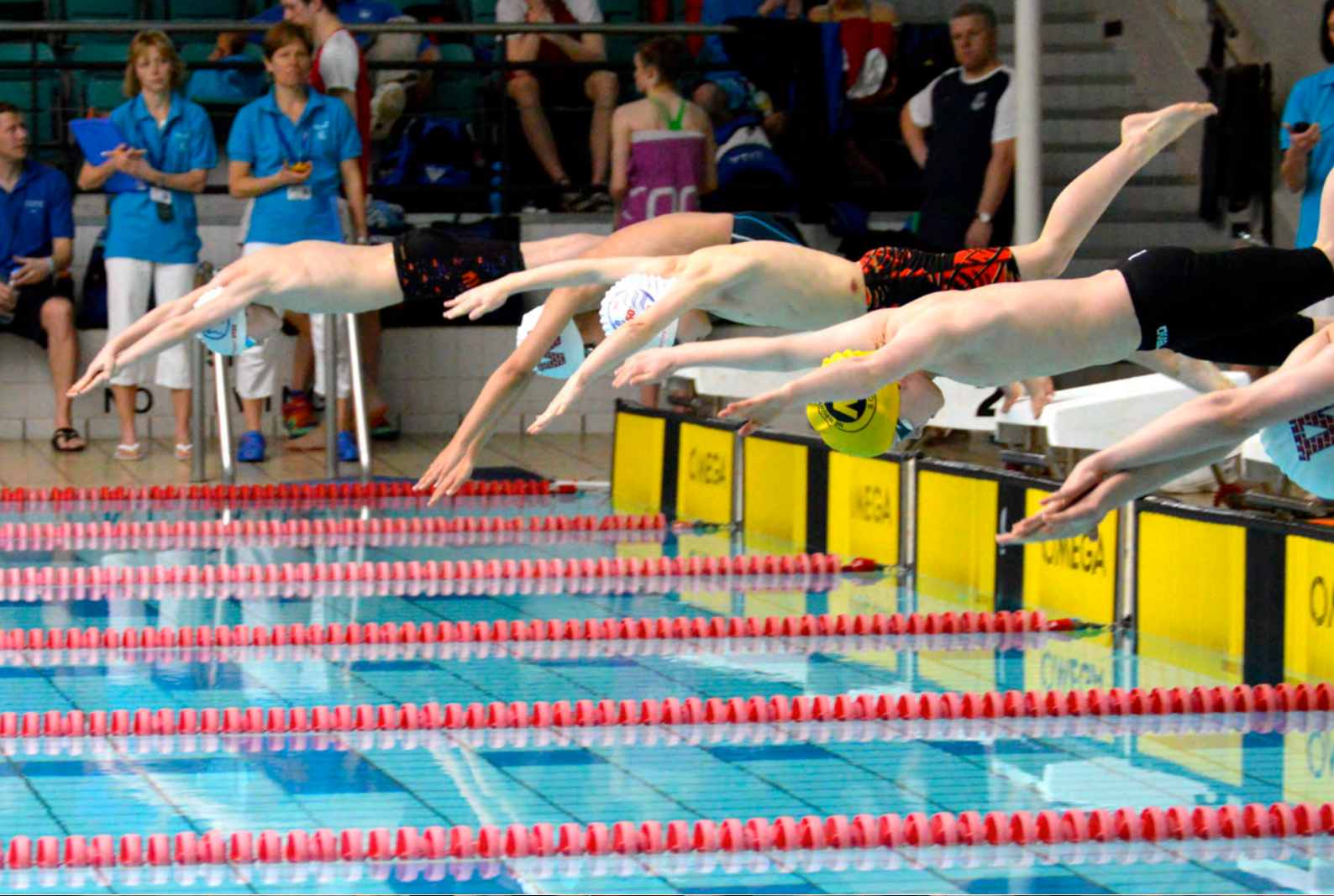

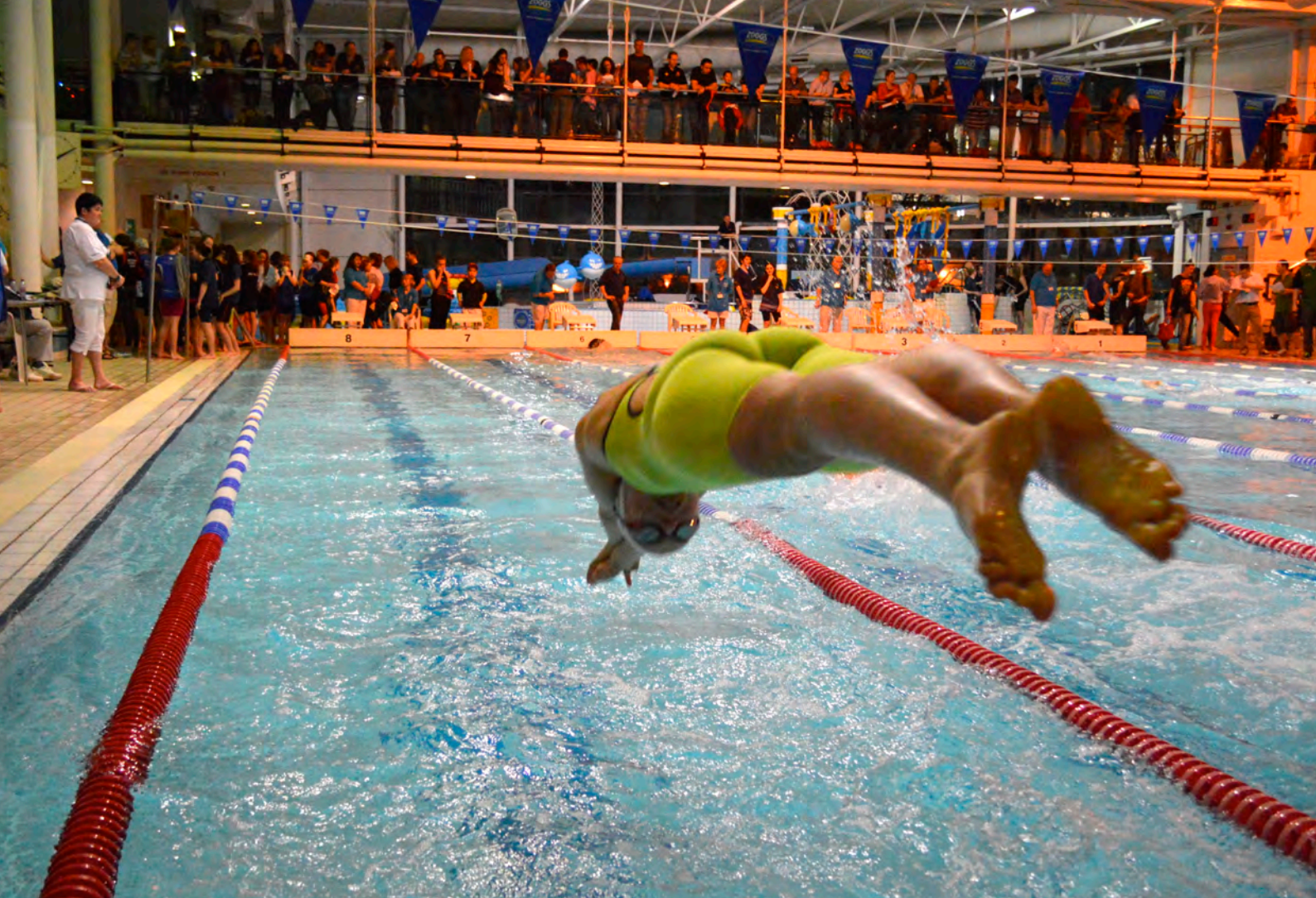

- 2 The competitions shall be open to ASA registered Masters Swimmers who are members of a swimming club affiliated to the County Association.
- 3 Age groups shall be:

A	25 - 29	B	30 - 34	C	35 - 39	D	40 - 44	E	45 - 49
F	50 - 54	G	55 - 59	H	60 - 64	J	65 - 69	K	70 plus

The ages shown are as at 31 December in the year of competition. Competitors in age group 'A' must be at least 25 on the day of the event.

A Senior Group [S] may be included age 18-24. Competitors in age group 'S' must be at least 18 on the day of the event.

- 3 All events shall be swum with heat declared winners. Swimmers shall be entered into heats in the male and female events in the order of their submitted times, which must be for a 25 metre pool, with the slowest competitors swimming in the first heats irrespective of their age group. Only under exceptional circumstances shall a competitor be allowed to compete out of programme order in a faster heat, and then only with the permission of the referee.
- 4 Medals shall be awarded to the first three male and female competitors in each age group.
- 5 The entry fees shall be determined by the County Management Board annually.
