REGISTRATION

All swimmers need to register and confirm they are swimming in the events which they have been accepted for. There will be separate registrations for each session. **Registration closes at the start of the warm-up.**

Registration will take place in the foyer, on the ground floor close to the changing room entrance. There will be separate registration sheets for open/male and female categories.

Swimmers should confirm which events they are swimming in when registering as well as if they wish to withdraw from any events. No refunds can be provided for withdrawals.

If you have not registered by the time registration closes, you will be withdrawn from all your events that session and you will not be allowed to compete.

ACCESS POOLSIDE

For the safety and welfare of all swimmers, spectators and parents are NOT allowed poolside or in the changing rooms during the meet. Swimmers will be looked after by their coaches and team managers poolside.

Only qualified Coaches and Team Managers ("TMs") who have purchased poolside passes for the meet will be permitted poolside. Coaches and TMs can collect their poolside passes from the registration desk. If registration is closed, passes can be collected from the desk upstairs at the spectator entry desk.

As lessons are taking place in the pool just before the meet, **access to the changing rooms will be only be permitted from 10:15.** Please wait in the foyer, cafe or car park areas before this time.

Large bags are not permitted poolside. Swimmers should leave large bags in the changing room lockers. **You will need to use your own padlock for the lockers.**

SPECTATORS

Access to the spectator gallery is available from 10:15. Seating in the spectator's gallery is limited and spaces will be allocated on a first come - first served basis. Please use the seating provided, standing at the back is not permitted due to fire regulations.

The spectator gallery is accessed from the gallery level, up the stairs opposite reception.



Admission is £6 for 1 session, or £10 for the whole day.

Payment must be made by credit/debit card, we will not accept cash payments.

Programmes will be on sale at the spectator entry desk.

The Braywick leisure car park is free on Sundays. Inside, there is a large café serving hot and cold refreshments, snacks, pastries and pizzas. Alternatively there is an Esso garage about ½ mile down the road with a Greggs, Subway and an ASDA.

WARM UP

The main pool will be available for warming up at the start of each session. Swimmers should swim in the direction indicated by the lane direction cards during warm up or as directed by the announcer. Sprint lanes will also be announced (for start practise).

There will be two 20 minute warm ups, check with your coach/TM which warm-up you're are in.



BEFORE YOUR EVENT

When called for an event by the announcer, swimmers must report to the competition stewards to be organised by heat and lane number. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to report to the stewarding area (in the changing room area) in good time for their swim. Start lists will be provided to team managers and posted online before the start of each session.

If a swimmer cannot be found in time for the start of their heat, the event will be run without them and they will lose their swim.

Heats will be run with all ages seeded together based on entry times and the slowest swimmers first. The final heat will be spearheaded with faster swimmers towards the centre.

SWIMMING RULES

The meet will be held under Swim England Laws & Technical Rules of Racing. No jury of appeal will be appointed.

Over the top starts will be used wherever possible to ensure that the events run to time. Swimmers should remain in their lane after finishing their race until the next race has started, unless instructed to leave the pool by the referee earlier.

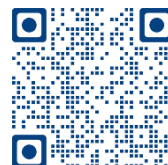
When leaving the pool, swimmers should leave promptly and by the sides so as not to interfere with the timing equipment.

The teaching pool is closed and not available for warm down during the meet.

MEDALS

Medals will be awarded to the top three placed swimmers in each event for each age group category (9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, & 17). Presentations will not be made. Awards should be collected from the medal table once the official results are posted.



VIDEO RECORDING / PHOTOGRAPHS AND MOBILE TELEPHONES

The use of Video and still cameras is permitted at the event, in line with Swim England guidance. Any photos and videos taken may only be for personal use and may not be broadcast (including web-streaming) or published without the prior written consent of the Promoter.

Please do not use flash photography as this is distracting for the swimmers and officials.

Any form of photography is strictly prohibited in the changing area. Use of a mobile phone or device in the changing area (including simply making a call) is strictly prohibited. Breaching these rules will have serious consequences.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

All participants must observe the rule and safety precautions in operation at the venue. Swimmers and coaches must ensure that they take no action that could potentially endanger themselves or others.

Please keep fire exits and access routes clear. Due to the limited pool deck area, large bags are not allowed poolside, please use the lockers in the changing area and ask swimmers to bring a smaller poolside bag for any belongings they want poolside.

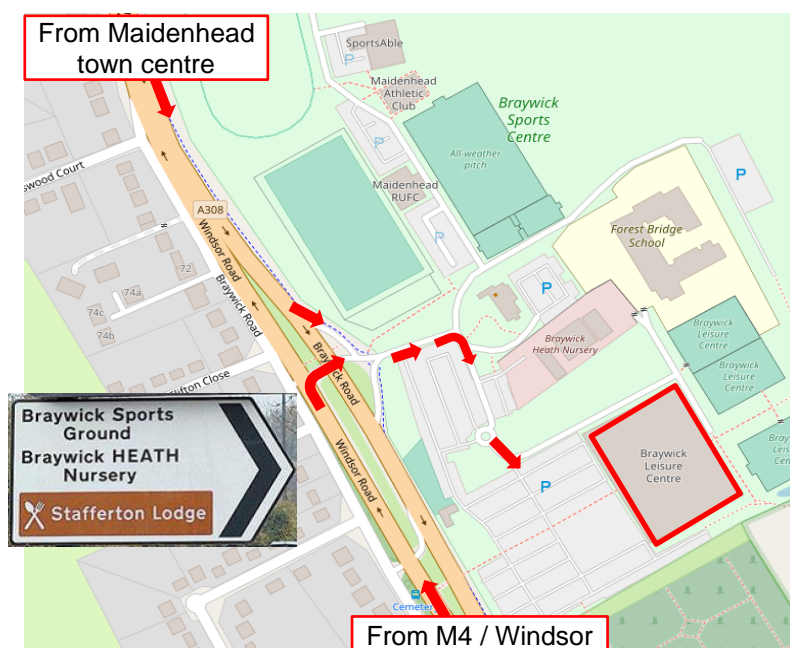
Possessions and articles must not be left unattended as neither the Promoter nor the leisure centre will accept any liability for any loss or damage.

The changing rooms are unisex and will be patrolled during the Meet to ensure the safety of all the swimmers.

No wet clothing is allowed in the spectator seating area. Prior to leaving the pool area, swimmers must dry off and put on appropriate clothing and footwear.
