County and Age Group Championships 2015

(Under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules)

Entry Conditions and Procedure

Introduction

1. The County Championships and County Age Group Championships are run as an integrated meet and are governed by the County Championships Conditions and County Age Group Championships Conditions as approved by the County Executive. These can be found on the BSBASA website (www.bsbasa.org). The key requirements of these Conditions are summarised in this entry procedure document.
2. The format of these championships and a number of procedural matters have changed following feedback from clubs and coaches after the 2014 championships (and the resulting changes to the Championship and Age Group conditions). Full details are contained in this entry pack.

Eligibility

3. Competitors who are members of clubs affiliated to the Association on the closing date for entries and who are registered with the ASA with Category 2 membership may enter individual events. However a competitor may only represent one club in the Championships. Furthermore a competitor who has entered BSBASA Championships in any other discipline in 2015 can only swim in the name of the same club represented in that earlier Championship. Finally a competitor who has swum in the Championship or Age Group Competitions of another county in 2015 may not enter.
4. All clubs affiliated to the Association may enter team events. Individual competitors selected to represent clubs must be eligible to enter individual events.

Competitors with disabilities

5. Classified Disability Swimmers may enter any event provided they meet the eligibility requirements above. The qualifying times will be extended by 25% (subject to the promoter's discretion) and competitors wishing to take advantage of the extended qualifying times should contact the organisers (championships@bsbasa.org) regarding the entry process.

Individual Events

6. The following individual events are included in the championships

Freestyle	50m, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m (girls only), 1500m (boys only)
Backstroke	50m, 100m, 200m
Butterfly	50m, 100m, 200m
Breaststroke	50m, 100m, 200m
Individual Medley	100m*, 200m, 400m

* The 100m IM is not a championship event and is restricted to swimmers 14 years and under. 9 and 10 year olds may not enter any 100m events except the 100m IM, or any events over 200m

7. There are separate events for male and female competitors. Please note the 800m and 1500m events will be swum long course at the Wycombe Sports Centre 50m Pool and **not** at Maidenhead
8. Ages are at 21 March 2015.

Team Events

9. The following team events are included:

Male

Open 4 x 50m Freestyle Team
Youths 4 x 100m Freestyle Team
BAGCATS 4 x 100m Freestyle Team
11 years & under 4 x 50m Freestyle Team

Female

Open 4 x 50m Medley Team
Youths 4 x 100m Medley Team
BAGCATS 4 x 100m Medley Team
11 years & under 4 x 50m Medley Team

Mixed

Open 4 x 50m Freestyle Team
Open 4 x 50m Medley Team

Mixed events comprise two male and two female swimmers, who may swim in any order.

10. Please note the open team events (male, female and mixed) will be swum long the Wycombe Sports Centre 50m Pool and **not** at Maidenhead.

11. The age conditions are as follows:

Youths	All boys and girls must be 15 -18 on 9 August 2015
BAGCATS	All boys and girls must be 10 -14 on 9 August 2015
11 years and under	All boys and girls must be 9 -11 years at 21 March 2015

12. There are no minimum consideration times for team events, and it is intended that the County team events should be a good opportunity for swimmers to gain experience of relay team racing. It is therefore expected that there will be a wide range of entry times in each event. Would clubs and coaches please make sure that the entry times are appropriate for the team that is expected to swim on the day and think twice about entering teams that are likely to be way below the standards of any of the other competing clubs.

13. As in 2014 most of the team events are in the same session which is the concluding session of the meet. We are hoping that this session will again have that special atmosphere that is present at team events and will be a fitting conclusion to the Championships.

Entry Procedure - General

14. All entries must be made and paid for on-line by following the link at www.bsbasa.org. Please note that entry will be by ASA number and only those swimmers who are registered with clubs in the County and who have a Category 2 ASA registration are permitted to enter.

15. The closing date for submitting and paying for entries is midnight on 28 January 2015. No entries will be accepted or entry times updated after that date.

16. Entry fees are £5.25 per individual event and £7.00 per team event. No entries will be accepted without payment of the appropriate entry fee. Except where it is not possible to accept entries (see below) entry fees are not refundable. Entry fees in respect of an incorrect entry will be forfeit.

Entry Procedure - Individual events

17. Swimmers must have achieved the consideration time during the 12 months ending on 18 January 2015. These times must have been achieved at ASA licensed meets (Level 1 – 4) and be included in the ASA Ranking Database at the date of your entry. When you enter, the on-line entry system will download the fastest short course time (actual or converted) achieved in the 12 months ended on 18 January 2015 from the ASA Rankings database and where this is equal to or faster than the consideration time, this will be the swimmers entry time. It is not possible to amend this time.

Conversions from long course (50m) to short course (25m) will be done using the equivalent performance application (based on tables published by the ASA) at www.bsbasa.org. Only times set in 25m or 50m pools are eligible.

18. Currently ASA Rankings do not capture relay lead off times set in licensed meets. Such times set at licensed meets may be used for entry but it will be necessary to submit appropriate documentary evidence signed by the race or meet referee (in line with ASA guidance). Such evidence must be submitted in advance. Split times from longer events will not be accepted for entry.
19. Documentary evidence of relay lead off times must be submitted no later than midnight on 23 January 2015. If this is accepted by the meet organiser, the appropriate time will be made available in the on-line entry system. Evidence must be submitted via www.bsbasa.org where there will be full instructions.
20. Swimmers who have elected to keep their membership and ranking information private will not be able to enter using the on-line system. These swimmers should amend their membership status with the ASA and then use the on-line system. Only in very exceptional circumstances, will the Entries Secretary through his discretion allow this condition to be relaxed and even then only after suitable evidence of the circumstances and entry times have been provided which must be at least 10 days prior to the closing date.
21. Please note that meeting the consideration time does not guarantee entry and depending on the volume of entries it may not be possible to accept all entries from swimmers who have achieved the consideration time. Where this is necessary, swimmers with the fastest times will be accepted taking into account the need to be fair between age groups. Where possible, swimmers who are not accepted may be nominated as reserves, and may be able to swim in the event of withdrawals.
22. Consideration times are attached and are stated to tenths. For the avoidance of doubt, where the consideration time is stated as (say) 1:37.0, a time of 1:37.00 meets the entry criterion, but 1:37.01 does not.

Entry Procedure - Team events

23. It is not necessary to name the swimmers from whom each team will be selected on the entry form, however the names, dates of birth ASA registration numbers and swim order of the selected swimmers must be declared on the team declaration form which must be posted before the time indicated on the form. All teams must be entered and paid for using the on-line system at www.bsbasa.org.

Notification of Accepted Swims

24. Entries successfully received by the on-line system can be viewed at any time at www.bsbasa.org, but receipt of entries does not guarantee acceptance. Accepted swims will be posted at www.bsbasa.org as soon as possible after the closing date. It is the responsibility of swimmers and clubs to check entry details carefully before the entries deadline. Processing errors notified before the start of the meet will be corrected. It is most unlikely that errors can be corrected once the meet has started.

Meet details

25. The order of events is attached. Please note that the session times are provisional and will be confirmed once entries have been processed. Swimmers should consider carefully which events they enter, and in particular the possibility that if they qualify for finals they may need to swim a number of races over a very short period of time. It will not be possible to have a break in the programme to accommodate multiple swims. Swimmers who qualify for finals (including Junior finals) are expected to swim in those finals, and withdrawals from finals should only occur in exceptional circumstances.

26. Swimmers whose entries have been accepted, but who do not intend to swim must withdraw. Withdrawal must be notified to each club's designated team manager, who will in turn notify the meet organisers (before the start of the warm up for each session). Clubs with an unacceptable level of unreported withdrawals will be reported to the Performance Swimming Events Committee who may impose a penalty, including a fine.
27. Team declaration forms must be collected at the start of session 1. These must be completed with the details of the swimmers who will actually compete and must be posted prior to the time stated on the form (sessions 5 and 8). If forms are not posted, then swimmers and teams will not be able to swim. It is not necessary to withdraw from these events. Teams who do not swim the declared swimmers in the declared order will be disqualified.
28. With the exception of the 400m, 800m and 1500m individual freestyle events and all team events, all heats will be seeded fast to slow (this is to allow the swimmers who are most likely to qualify for finals to have the greatest amount of rest). The 400m, 800m and 1500m individual freestyle events and all team events will be seeded slow to fast.
29. The meet will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules, and in particular the one start rule shall apply.

Awards

Age group awards

30. Awards will be made to the winners in the following age groups,
- 10 years & under, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15/16 years, and 17 years & over.
- NB 9 and 10 year olds may not enter any 100m events except the 100m IM, or any events over 200m. Swimmers over 14 years may not enter the 100m IM.
31. All age group awards will be made on a heat declared winner basis. Age Group Medals will be awarded for first, second and third place. Rosettes will be awarded for places 4 to 8. Ages are at 21 March 2015 (the final day of the championships). Swimmers who are under 9 at 21 March 2015 are not eligible to enter.

County Championship

32. For events of 200m and over, the County Championship will be decided on heat times. The County Championship Trophy and a County Championship Gold Medal will be awarded to the swimmer achieving the fastest time in the heats. The second and third fastest swimmers will be awarded County Championships Medals.
33. For 50m and 100m events (except the 100m Individual Medley which is not a County Championship event) there will be County Championship finals. The fastest eight swimmers in the heats will swim the County Championship Final. There will be two reserves, and reserves will be promoted to the Championship final in the event of a faster swimmer withdrawing. There will be no swim offs for equal placed swimmers and in such cases the number of swimmers in the championship final shall be reduced as necessary. The winner of the final will be awarded the County Championship Trophy and a County Championship Gold Medal. The swimmers placed second and third will be awarded County Championships Medals.

Junior Championship

34. For events of 200m and over, and the 100m Individual Medley, the Junior County Championship will be decided on heat times. The Junior Championship Trophy and a County Championship Gold Medal will be awarded to the Junior swimmer (aged 14 years and under on 21 March 2015) achieving the fastest time in the heats. The second and third fastest Junior swimmers will be awarded County Championships Medals.
35. For 50m and 100m events (except the 100m Individual Medley) there will be Junior Championship finals. The fastest eight Junior swimmers in the heats (excluding Junior swimmers who qualify for the County Championship final) will swim the Junior Championship Final. There will be four reserves, and reserves will be promoted to the Junior final in the event of a faster swimmer withdrawing (or being promoted to the County Championship final). There will be no swim offs for equal placed swimmers and in such cases the number of swimmers in the Junior final shall be reduced as necessary. The finish order in the Junior final shall determine the Junior Championship placing, except where Junior swimmers are placed in the Championship final. In such cases all Junior swimmers placed in the Championship final will be placed, in finish order, above the Junior final winner, regardless of the respective times achieved in the finals.
36. The Junior swimmer placed first will be awarded the County Championship Trophy and a County Championship Gold Medal. The swimmers placed second and third will be awarded County Championships Medals.

Team event awards

37. The winners of all team events will be determined on a heat declared winner basis. The team winning the Open event will be awarded The County Championship Trophy and each swimmer will receive a County Championship Gold Medal. The team winning the BAGCAT event will be awarded The Junior Championship Trophy and each swimmer will receive a County Championship Gold Medal. In both cases, the teams placed second and third will also each receive a County Championship Medal and rosettes will be awarded to each swimmer in the teams placed 4th to 8th.
38. For the Youth and 11 years and under team events, Age Group Medals will be awarded to each swimmer in the teams placed first, second and third. Rosettes will be awarded to each swimmer in the teams placed fourth to eighth.

Aggregate awards

39. The male and female club aggregate awards trophies will be awarded to the club with the highest points score. Points will be awarded to the first eight competitors in each age group of each event, including the team events, in the following manner: Winner 8 points; Second 7 points; Third 6 points; Fourth 5 points; Fifth 4 points; Sixth 3 points; Seventh 2 points; Eighth 1 point. No two clubs can make use of the same competitor for the purpose of counting points in these competitors in any one year.
40. The total number of points obtained by the Club shall be added together on completion of the Championships and the Club obtaining the highest aggregate shall be declared the winner. In the event of a dead heat on aggregate points, the club with the greatest number of first places shall be declared the winner, and if this also produces a dead heat, the Clubs concerned shall be declared joint winners.
41. The age group aggregate awards will be awarded to the 10 - 14 years and under girl and boy (at 21 March 2015) who achieve the highest points scores. Points will be awarded according the place achieved in the relevant age group for the following events:

50m Freestyle, 50m Backstroke, 50m Butterfly, 50m Breaststroke, 200m Freestyle and 200m Individual medley.

First - 6 pts, Second - 5 pts, Third, - 4 pts , Fourth - 3 pts, Fifth - 2 pts, Sixth -1 point.

Only times achieved in heats will be taken into account for the BAGCAT awards.

Ages are at 21 March 2015.

9 year olds are not eligible for BAGCAT awards.

Trophies

44. Trophies awarded annually may be kept by the winners subject to completing the necessary documentation as regards its safekeeping and return. Any holder of a trophy who fails to return that trophy by the specified date shall not be allowed to take custody of any trophies which he or she might be awarded during the County Championships in that calendar year.

Coaches passes

45. Clubs may apply for up to 4 coaches passes via the on-line entry system. The nominated representative of each club will be provided with a link to apply for coaches passes. The cost of a coaches pass is £15 per coach and each club entering is required to purchase at least one coaches pass. Only coaches wearing a coaches pass will be permitted on poolside. Please note that we are unable to provide catering for coaches.

Still and video photography

46. In line with ASA guidance on the taking of photos, the promoters of this event will require that any person wishing to engage in any video or still photograph (including mobile phones and tablet computers) register their details at the spectator entrance desk before carrying out any such photography.. They will be issued with a white wrist band which must be worn and visible at all times. Once registered we are happy for them to take photos and videos where their swimmer is

the main subject of the photo. Any such photos and videos may only be for their own personal use and cannot be broadcast or published without the prior written consent of the Promoter. The Berkshire and South Buckinghamshire ASA will also have an official photographer to record the competition and images may be used for County publications and the County website (within the relevant ASA guidance). By entering, swimmers accept that their image may be captured and used as described above, Swimmers and parents who do not wish their images to be used should contact the promoter in advance of the event.

Other matters

47. Any matter not covered by the above conditions shall be determined by the BSBASA Performance Swimming Events Committee, and in the case of matters requiring a decision during the meet by the chairman of that committee and as many of its members who are available.
