Chesham SC, Chalfont Otters SC and Bracknell & Wokingham SC are due to complete their SwimMark full submission at the June panel meeting, submission deadline Friday 17th May 2019.

Electric Eels maintained their SwimMark accreditation at the March 2019 panel meeting. Unfortunately Amersham SC did not submit and have subsequently lost their SwimMark accreditation.

Please note, from 2019, no evidence with Swim 21 logos will be accepted, please ensure all documents have the SwimMark logo. Please can clubs also ensure all swim 21 logos are removed from websites and replaced with the SwimMark logo.

Coaching courses

Rosa Gallop is in the process of setting up an Assistant Coaching course at Bishops Gate School, Ascot. Dates – 28th, 29th and 30th June 2019. Details will be circulated once finalised.

The Master's Assistant Coach course held at Bracknell went very well. The Masters are now asking for a Coach course (Level 2). Rosa is waiting for the IOS to agree to this. The course was a normal Assistant coach course so the candidates can coach Masters or Club swimmers but there were lectures to cover Master swimmers and the swimmers used were Master swimmers as well as the Coaches were all coaching Master swimmers. There was some excellent feedback from the candidates.
