1 MINUTES

- Regional Office Manager, Swim England South East, forwarding an e-mail from the Head of Development at Swim England about the report "A Decade of Decline", which shows a worrying future for swimming pools;
- Regional Office Manager, Swim England South East, asking whether the Association would be levying an affiliation fee in 2022: following informal consultation between the Officers, the response "No" was sent;

 Gordon Dart, of Reading SC and Reading Cygnets SC, asking the Association to support the campaign for the new pool at Reading (or part thereof) to be named as a memorial to the late Harry Wild, a coach with both clubs for many years, who died earlier this year.
